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AGREEMENT TO SPEND TOWN HIGHWAY FUNDS 2013

TOWN OF West Sparta
COUNTY OF Livingston

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the state for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$ 30,000.00 may be expended for general repairs upon 15 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.

2. IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the improvement of town highways:

(a) On the road commencing at Presbyterian (Moffat Rd)
and leading to Pauline, a distance of .76 miles.
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 35,000.00

Type Gravel Width of traveled surface 22 ft.
Thickness 5" Subbase Gravel

(b) On the road commencing at Presbyterian (Moore Rd North)
and leading to Dead end, a distance of 1.2 miles.
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 70,000.00

Type Reclamation Width of traveled surface 22 ft.
Thickness 6" Subbase Gravel
includes 2 passes of stone and oil

(c) On the road commencing at Pauline Road-Ditching
and leading to _____, a distance of _____ miles.
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ _____

and leading to Presbyterian, a distance of .96 miles.
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 2,000.00
Type Gravel/Blacktop Width of traveled surface 22 FT.
Thickness _____ Subbase Gravel
clean ditches where needed clean out pipes

(a) On the road commencing at Appleville rd (Everman rd)
 and leading to RT 63 Bridge, a distance of .30 miles.
 there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 15,000.00
