

AGREEMENT TO SPEND TOWN HIGHWAY FUNDS

TOWN OF West Sparta
COUNTY OF Livingston

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the state for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$ 60,000.00 may be expended for general repairs upon 4.7 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.

2. IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the improvement of town highways:

(a) On the road commencing at White bridge Route 36
and leading to Appleville Rd., a distance of 1.24 miles.
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 30,000.00

Type Surface Coat Width of traveled surface 22 Feet
Thickness 1 3/8 Subbase Gravel
one pass 1" stone
one pass 3/4 stone

(b) On the road commencing at Shaw Rd Nunda Byersville Rd
and leading to Redmond Rd., a distance of 1.7 miles.
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 18,000.00

Type Surface Coat Width of traveled surface 22 Feet
Thickness 3/8 Subbase Gravel
2 passes 3/8 stone in dirt
1 pass 3/8 full length

(c) On the road commencing at Kyserville Rd. Route 36
and leading to Route 36, a distance of .7 miles.
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 8,000.00

Type Surface Coat Width of traveled surface 22 Feet
Thickness 3/8 Subbase Gravel

No moneys set aside for such improvements shall be expended, nor shall any work be undertaken on such improvements until the Town Superintendent approves the plans, specifications and estimates for such construction.

This agreement shall take effect when it is approved by the Town Board.
