AGREEMENT TO SPEND TOWN HIGHWAY FUNDS

COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the state for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ may be expended for general repairs upon \_\_\_\_\_ miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.

2. IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the improvement of town highways:

(a) On the road commencing at Pauline Rd. Presbyterian  
and leading to Moffat, a distance of .96 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 20,000.00

Type Gravel Width of traveled surface 22'  
Thickness 4" Subbase Gravel

(b) On the road commencing at Moffat Presbyterian  
and leading to Pauline, a distance of .76 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 18,000.00

Type Gravel Width of traveled surface 22'  
Thickness 4" Subbase Gravel

(c) On the road commencing at Veley Rd. Presbyterian  
and leading to Dead End, a distance of .80 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 18,000.00

Type Gravel Width of traveled surface 22'  
Thickness 4" Subbase Gravel

No moneys set aside for such improvements shall be expended, nor shall any work be undertaken on such improvements until the Town Superintendent approves the plans, specifications and estimates for such construction.

This agreement shall take effect when it is approved by the Town Board.
