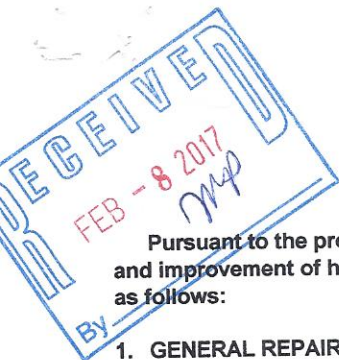


# AGREEMENT TO SPEND TOWN HIGHWAY FUNDS

2017



TOWN OF West Sparta  
COUNTY OF Livingston

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the state for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$ 45,000 may be expended for general repairs upon \_\_\_\_\_ miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.

2. IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the improvement of town highways:

(a) On the road commencing at Presbyterian Rd. (Moffet Rd.)  
and leading to Pauline Rd., a distance of .76 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 29,000.00

Type Oil-Stone Width of traveled surface 22 feet  
Thickness Two Coats Subbase Gravel  
Oil-Stone a total of 3,855 ft.

(b) On the road commencing at Coffee Hill Rd (Woodsville Rd.)  
and leading to State Route 36, a distance of .88 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 42,000.00

Type Oil-Stone Width of traveled surface 20 feet  
Thickness One-Coat Subbase Gravel  
Oil-Stone a total of 3,760 ft.

(c) On the road commencing at Moore Rd. (Reed Rd.)  
and leading to Kenney Rd., a distance of .25 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_

Type Oil-Stone Width of traveled surface 22 feet  
Thickness One-Coat Subbase Gravel

(Cont. →)

No moneys set aside for such improvements shall be expended, nor shall any work be undertaken on such improvements until the Town Superintendent approves the plans, specifications and estimates for such construction.

This agreement shall take effect when it is approved by the Town Board.

2. IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the improvement of town highways:

(a) On the road commencing at Nunda Bressville Rd. - (Mare Rd.)  
and leading to Reed Rd., a distance of .76 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 80,000.00

Type oil-stone Width of traveled surface 22 feet  
Thickness one-coat Subbase Gravel  
Final Coat of oil-stone Total Length 4900 ft.

(b) On the road commencing at Nunda Bressville Rd. - (Shaw Rd.)  
and leading to Redmond Rd., a distance of 1.10 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 15,000.00

Type oil-stone Width of traveled surface 22 feet  
Thickness one-coat Subbase Gravel  
final Coat of oil-stone total Length 4250 ft.

(c) On the road commencing at Mottat Rd. - (Pauline Rd.)  
and leading to Akesbytorian Rd., a distance of .50 miles.  
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 10,000.00

Type oil-stone Width of traveled surface 20 feet  
Thickness two-coat Subbase Gravel

No moneys set aside for such improvements shall be expended, nor shall any work be undertaken on such improvements until the Town Superintendent approves the plans, specifications and estimates for such construction.

This agreement shall take effect when it is approved by the Town Board.
